Mondays

Beachcombing & Shelling – Barefoot Beach Preserve: Mondays at 10 a.m. January through April. What do wrack lines, jellies, blue buttons, beachhoppers, ghosts, sea pork, and beans have in common? Come find out at this lecture on Beachcombing & Shelling. Meet at the Learning Center at Barefoot Beach Preserve. Program sponsored by Friends of Barefoot Beach Preserve. Program Cost: Free. There is an entrance fee into the park for those who do not have a current Collier County park permit. Directions: Turn south off of Bonita Beach Road onto Barefoot Beach Blvd. and go about 1 ½ miles to park entrance. Park in the first parking area on the right and meet at the Learning Center.



Wednesdays

Exploring Coastal Habitats – Barefoot Beach Preserve: Wednesdays at 9 a.m. January through April. Enjoy a guided walk to the estuary and along a sandy trail to the beach. Explore one of the most productive ecosystems in nature and the unique coastal habitats at the Preserve. Program sponsored by Friends of Barefoot Beach Preserve. Program cost: Free. There is an entrance fee into the park for those who do not have a current Collier County park permit. Directions: Turn south off of Bonita Beach Road onto Barefoot Beach Blvd. and go about 1 1/2 miles to park entrance. Park in the first parking area on the right and meet at the Learning Center.



Saturdays

Guided Nature Walk - Barefoot Beach Preserve: Saturdays at 9 a.m. January through April. Enjoy a guided walk along the boardwalk through a maritime forest and coastal strand. More than a nature walk, it's an educational experience! Learn the importance of barrier islands, how our ancestors used Florida's state tree and native plant communities on barrier islands of Southwest Florida. Program sponsored by Friends of Barefoot Beach Preserve. Program cost: Free. There is an entrance fee into the park for those who do not have a current Collier County park permit. Directions: Turn south off of Bonita Beach Road onto Barefoot Beach Blvd. and go about 1 1/2 miles to park entrance. Park in the first parking area on the right and meet at the Learning Center.
